

This clinic has adopted the HARMS Program for Safer Opioid Prescribing

As we have all heard, opioids pose a safety risk.

Unfortunately it is very difficult to know if someone is being helped or harmed.

If you are prescribed opioid medications for chronic pain then you will be asked to provide a urine sample at random time(s).

This sample will be checked to see which medications/drugs you are taking and help the prescriber identify if you may be at a higher risk from these medications.

This is a universal safety precaution.

The HARMS Program has been in practice elsewhere for many years and appears to be effective at identifying people that may be harmed be these medications.
